What do we do?

Unite landlords

- We bring together landlords by surveying our members on a range of important issues.
- We hold a yearly AGM

Represent landlords

- We frequently advocate for landlords at States and Government levels in these uncertain times (e.g. landlord licensing, rent controls, population policy, rent safe scheme, tenancy notice period extension, carbon neutral roadmap etc.).
